Upwardly Global and TIMGA Join Forces To Reshape the Future of International Medical Graduate Licensing



Upwardly Global has announced a partnership with The International Medical Graduates Academy (TIMGA) following the approval of legislation in August 2023, which establishes an alternative pathway to full licensure for international medical graduates (IMGs) in Illinois. In collaboration with Upwardly Global, they will engage with key stakeholders and contribute to the development of rules on IMG licensing as the state Legislature finalizes the process.

As part of New York State's Office of New Americans (ONA) Professional Pathways Program, Upwardly Global collaborates closely with the International Institute of Buffalo (IIB), a resettlement agency serving the Buffalo and Western New York region.



Upwardly Global has equipped IIB's job coaches with tools to better support newcomers with professional skills and online learning resources designed to teach newcomers about the U.S. job market. This ecosystem of support strengthens IIB's services for immigrants, refugees, and asylees in the region, lifting newcomers into skill-aligned jobs that support the entire community.

Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis Analyzes Upwardly Global Data in New Piece

The Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis recently posted an article on internationally trained physicians and how few of these professionals are on track to practice medicine in the U.S. They highlight points gleaned through a data-sharing partnership with Upwardly Global. In the article, they also touch on several initiatives and policies from state governments who are working to remove unnecessary roadblocks toward relicensure for internationally trained healthcare professionals. In 2023, Illinois introduced a new pathway to full licensure for IMGs, stemming from a 2022 permit program that enabled IMGs to practice medicine amid a healthcare labor shortage during the COVID-19 pandemic.
