- Integrate Salesforce with other systems using REST/SOAP APIs, middleware, or integration tools.
- Write efficient, scalable, and reusable code following Salesforce coding standards and best practices.
- Create and execute unit tests to ensure code quality and functionality.
- Troubleshoot and resolve issues with existing Salesforce implementations, including bug fixes and performance optimization.




- Assist in deploying Salesforce applications and configurations to different environments, following change management processes.
- Collaborate with administrators and other developers to support and maintain the Salesforce platform.
- Stay updated with the latest Salesforce features, releases, and industry trends, providing recommendations for improvement.
- Conduct security audits and implement necessary measures to ensure data privacy and compliance.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
